Item 1

Call to Order

Item 2 To Meet and Discuss with TxDot Officials on the Proposed 34 Feasibility and Alignment Study

Council was introduced to all the TxDot Officials and their positions. They went over the proposed study that had been the concern of the Council. Then John Poston spoke at length at the reason that Terrell and Kaufman preferred the Hwy 34 route to the others. Mayor Al Rudin took issue with him as to why the City of Oak Ridge was not considered in his discussions. The State stated that all that had been discussed would be reviewed, and future meetings would include Oak Ridge.
