**Item 1**

**Call to Order**

**Update on Court Activities/City Fees**

Donna Sprague reported on the month of September. There were 30 citations written in the month. The law firm on collections now have 684 warrants that they are calling and sending notices. Omni has told 3 of the warrants that their drivers license will not be renewed until full payment is received by the city. An account of the different provisions offered is as follows: Deferred Disposition 10, Defensive Driving 12, Payment Plans 37.

**Item 4**

**Report on Income and Expense of City**

The year was closed out on September 30, 2019. The Accountant has the files to audit the records. The year ended in good standing with all the budget funded completely. The City spent \$159,951.04 paving 5 of the streets in Oak Ridge. The council decided that we can start putting funds into the dedicated road fund again with the hopes that the other 4 streets can be paved soon. Abner Road will be completely resurfaced if the Proposition A passes in the County election.

**Update on Roads**

The Mayor is wanting to pave the next two streets Red Oak, and Oak Drive when the money is available. That will leave Zagota and Country Lane to complete the work. He stated that Oak Ridge is cracking on the side. Perhaps it is caused by the large garbage trucks. He will watch and report to Old Castle if it gets worse.
