Item 1

Item 2 Update on Court Activities/City Fees for March 2024

And our computer system will need to be updated; maybe we can use some of our grant money for that. Our Axon camera system is working well. We also need to put license plate readers in the next budget for the patrol cars.

April 8 was fairly quiet for traffic, but was a long day.

Item 8 Discussion by Code Enforcement Officer

Code Enforcement Officer David Lacy checked on several driveways and accessory buildings. He saw no problems with concrete pours that he inspected. There was one problem with a manhole that had concrete poured over it, completely covering it. It was reported and fixed promptly.

Item 9 Update on Roads

Per Mayor Rudin, CR140 has base in place. Oak Lane culvert is installed. CR279 has ditches almost complete. Rainy weather has delayed work, but will begin as soon as possible.
